Snow & fun parks

Ambitious winter sports fans can challenge fellow skiers in giant slalom races on various courses or work on improving their personal best times in one of the speed check zones. Certain routes are outfitted with Skimovie systems that capture racers on film from start to finish.

Toboggan runs

Featuring winding natural toboggan runs, evening rides through snow-covered forests, and much more, toboggan tracks in the Arlberg region provide exciting fun for the entire family. It is also an ideal fun activity in addition to skiing and snowboarding.

Toboggan runs: St. Anton: 4.2 km, illuminated natural toboggan run to the Dorfbahn gondola. Toboggan rental at the valley station. Weekly tobogganing evening according to the notice board and website.

Local & ski bus

The ski buses in St. Anton/St. Jakob and in Pettneu, Schnann and Flirsch are labeled with route numbers. Blue local buses run in Lech and Zürs. These buses and the Warth-Schröcken ski bus (between Schröcken-Unterboden and Warth-Lechleiten) and the Lechtal ski bus are (for the purpose of alpine skiing and snowboarding) free of charge with a valid ski ticket.


